

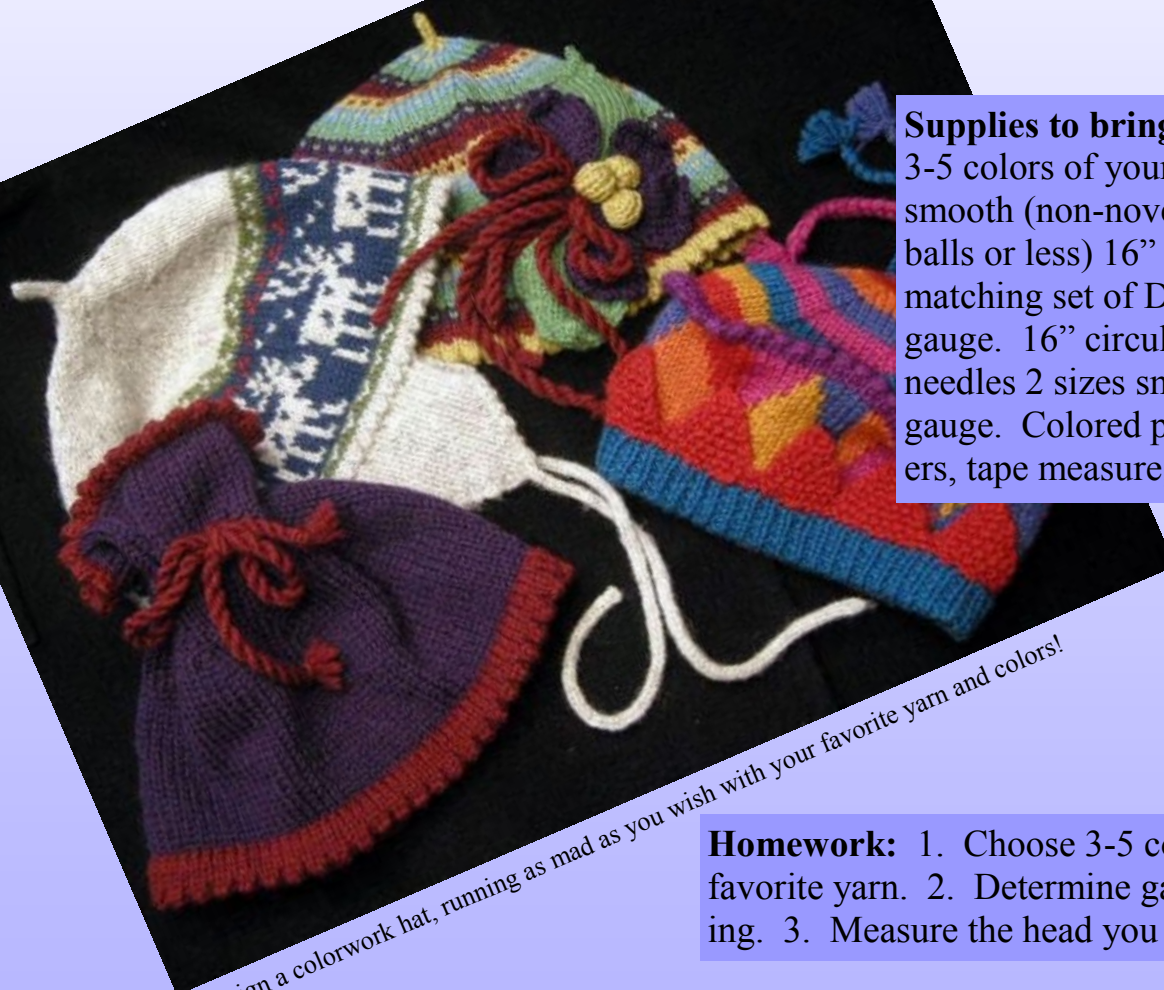
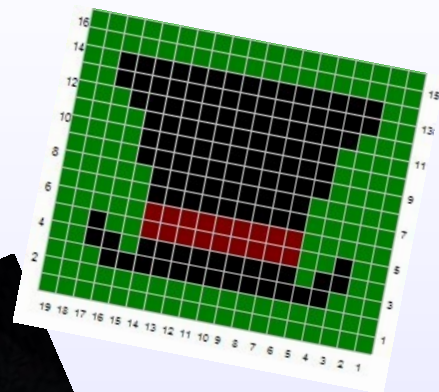
# Mad Hatters!

**As** a Mad Hatter, you will produce your own hat pattern, incorporating a stranded colorwork chart you create in class. Choose the design elements, draw a chart, and do some simple math. Just a few easy steps and you're off!

Design a colorwork hat, running as mad as you wish with your favorite yarn and colors!

### Supplies to bring:

3-5 colors of your favorite smooth (non-novelty) yarn (50g balls or less) 16" circular and matching set of DPN to suit gauge. 16" circular or straight needles 2 sizes smaller than gauge. Colored pencils or markers, tape measure, calculator

**Homework:** 1. Choose 3-5 colors of your favorite yarn. 2. Determine gauge by swatching. 3. Measure the head you intend to cover.
